

The following issue came up for discussion:

- I) The meeting was informed that additional laboratory facilities in Electrical Engineering Department have been put in place and upgraded to the level of accommodating more than 120 candidates and University of Kashmir needs to be approached and persuaded to grant sanction to enhancement of seats from 60 to 120 from the approaching academic year 2020-21.
- II) The issue regarding starting of PG Courses in Physics and Electronics came up for discussion and Committee members expressed satisfaction over the efforts made by the concerned HODs and Director (IQAC) which were appreciated by the Team of officers from University of Kashmir during their visit to the College. The courses shall start from Academic Session 2020-21 after selections are made by the University of Kashmir.
- III) The Committee was informed that since the restrictions owing to Covid-19 pandemic have been imposed by the Government, the Classwork is mostly done in online mode through different platforms. However, IQAC Cell has laid stress on educating students and encouraging them to come-up with some innovative ideas which are helpful in tackling problems arising out of Covid-19 pandemic.

The efforts of faculty members/students yielded results when some students of Mechanical Engineering Department innovated tools related to the Covid-19 patients in hospitals.

The Committee desired to ask faculty members to encourage more and more students to go in for innovations and Center for Innovation, Incubation Entrepreneurship Cell should provide all the help needed by students to translate their ideas into Innovative tools/equipment.
