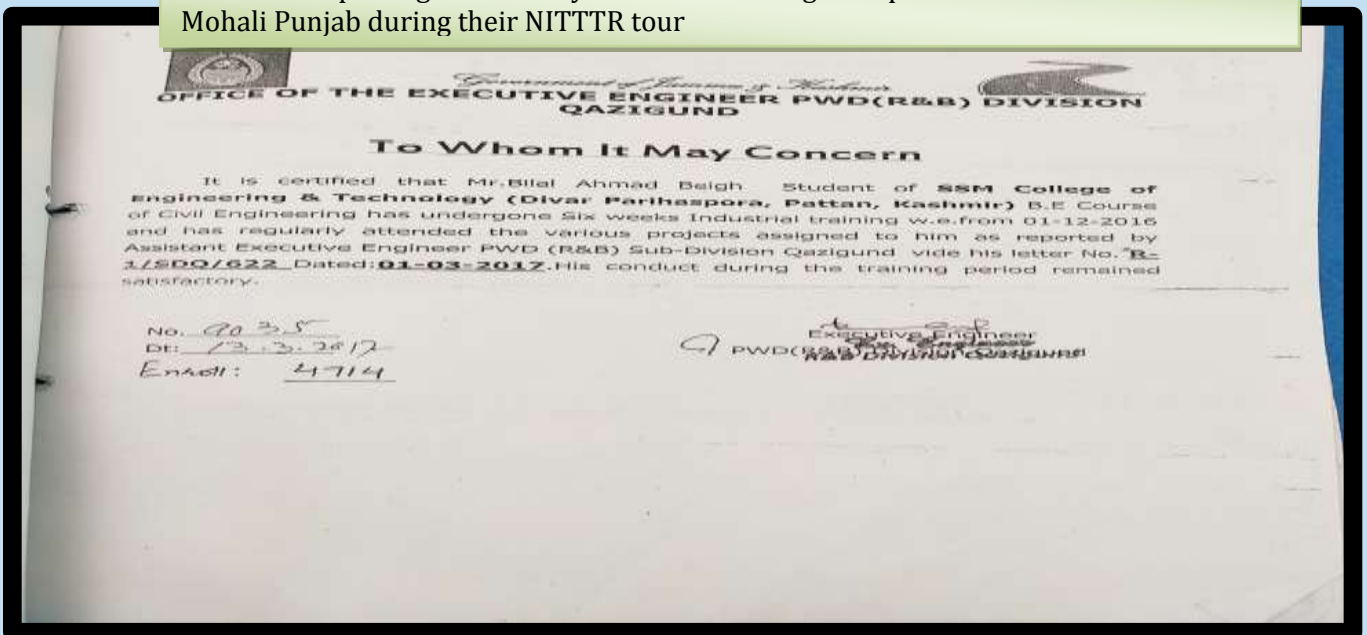

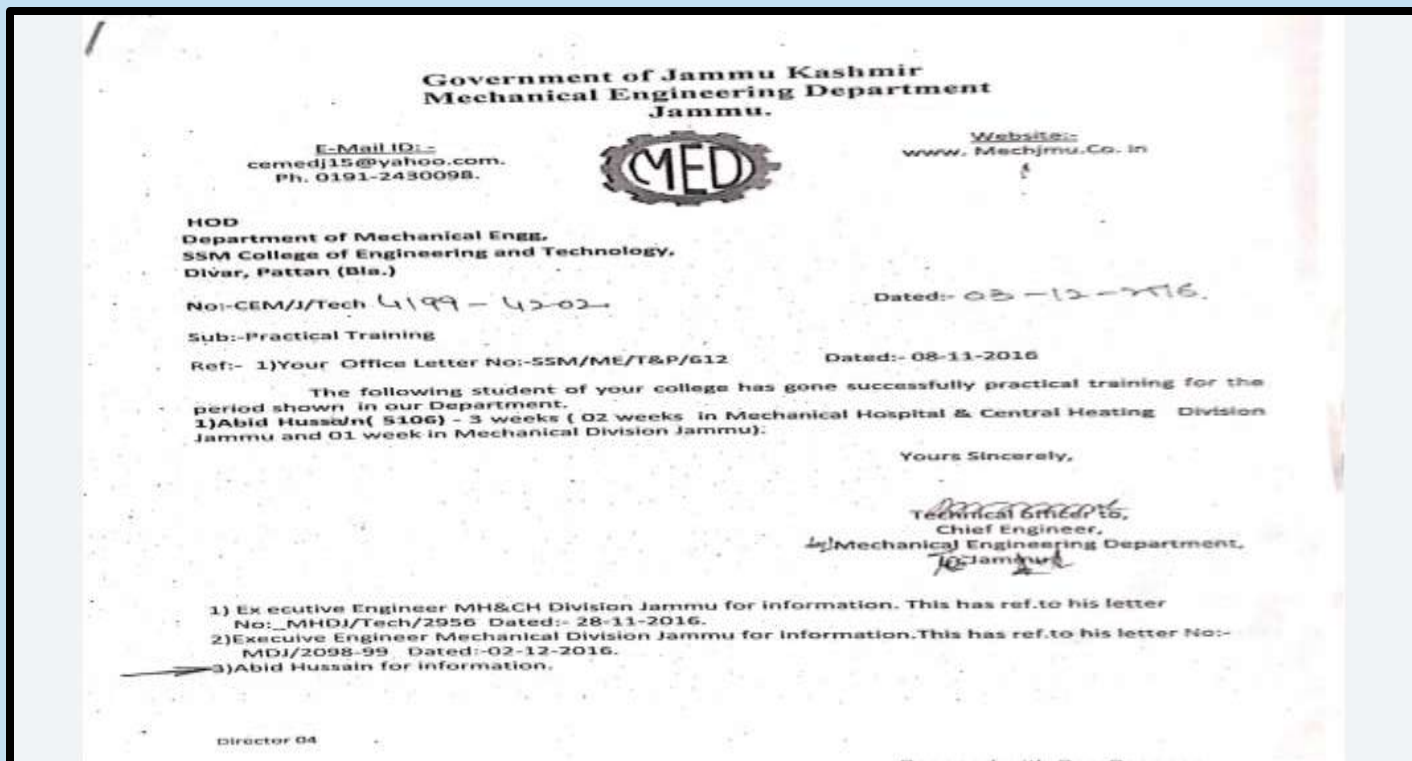

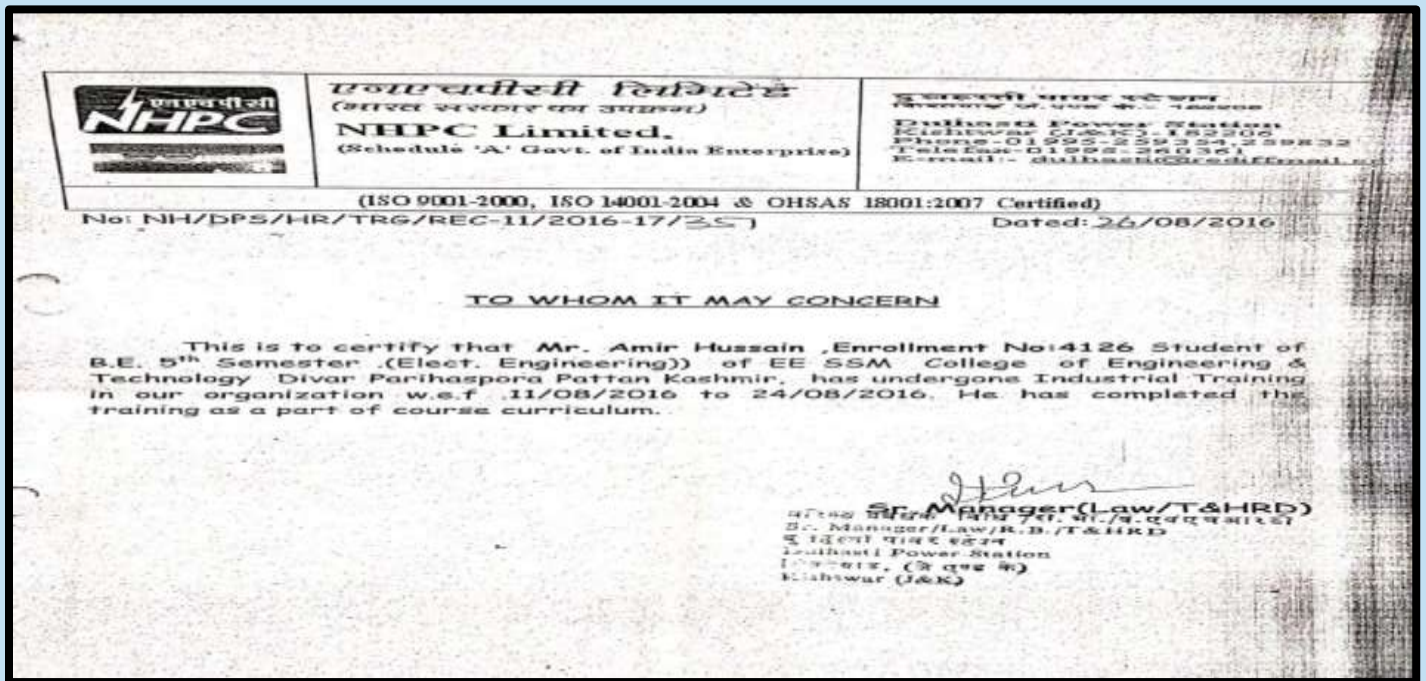

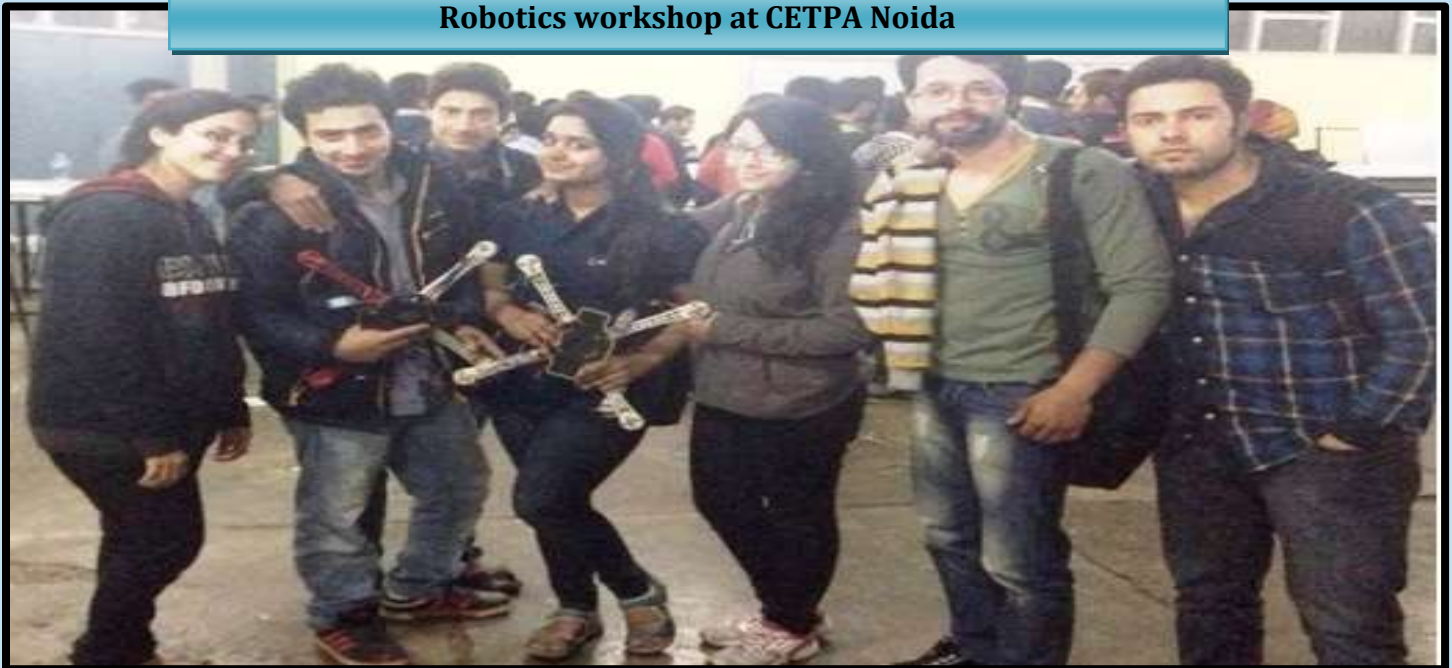

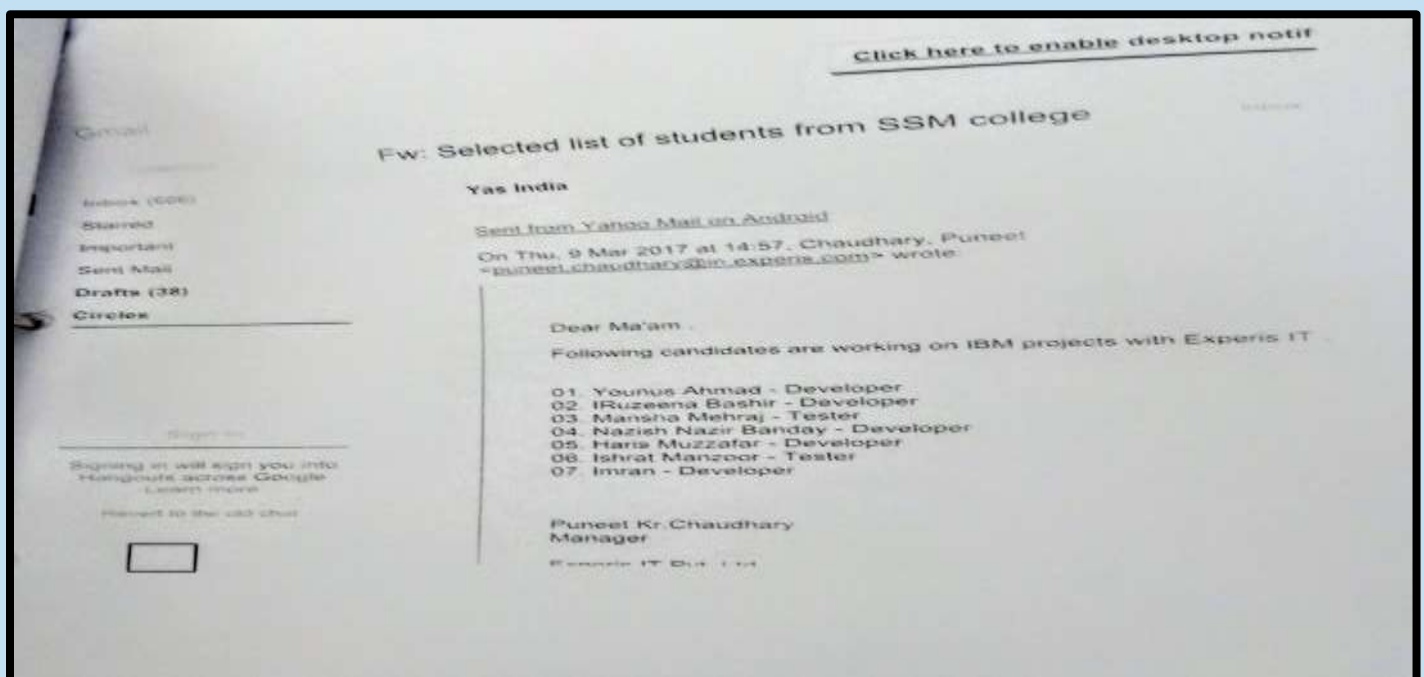

Whereas, the Public Works (R&B) and PHE/I&FC Departments referred 152 posts of Assistant Engineer (Civil) for recommendation of selection of suitable candidates vide communication Nos. PHE/I&FC/HRM/20/2013 dated: 30.05.2013, PW(R&B)HRM/36/2013 dated: 04.09.2013 and PW(R&B)HRM/36/2013 dated: 08.08.2014; and

whereas, the department-wise/category-wise break-up of posts so referred is given as under:-

whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission advertised these posts vide Notification Nos. 11-PSC (DR-P) OF 2013 dated 29-06-2013, 18-PSC (DR-P) OF 2013 dated 15-10-2013 & 01-PSC (DR-P) OF 2015 dated 25-01-2015. The last date for receipt of applications i.e. cut-off date was 29.07.2013, 15.11.2013 & 05.02.2016 respectively.

whereas, 5946 applications were received in response to all the three notifications and as the number of applicants was exceedingly large, a screening test was conducted on 13.09.2015 in terms of rule 40(1)a of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission (Business and Procedure) Rules, 1980; and

whereas, the result of the screening test was declared on 15.12.2015 and 479 applicants after application of the rule were shortlisted in the ratio of 1:3 and called for interview; and

whereas, the interview of the shortlisted candidates was conducted from 26.12.2016 to 1.01.2017 at Jammu with the assistance of experts from outside the state; and

whereas, at the time of conduct of interview the shortlisted candidates were asked to give their choice in order of preference for being considered against a particular notification on the basis of merit-cum-preference, should they fall in the consideration/selection zone in more than one notification; and

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whereas; 11 Candidates figuring against B.D Nos. 5,6,17,67,68,96,101,119,271,387 and 433 did not turn up for the interview.


whereas, the selection could not be finalized after conduct of interview as the Hon'ble Division bench of the High Court in the writ petition No. 2768-5/2015 titled Kaiser Ahmed Belg and Ors vs State & Ors restrained the Commission from finalizing the selection; and

whereas, the Hon'ble Division Bench has been pleased to dismiss the said writ petition with the directions to the Commission to conclude the selection process vide judgement dated 03.03.2017.

Now, therefore, on the basis of performance in the interview and the weightage earned in respect of academic merit, qualifications, experience together with the overall scholarship, award list of the candidates notification wise for the posts of Assistant Engineer (Civil) in PHE/I&FC and Public Works (R&B) Departments is hereby notified as Annexure 'A' to this notification.

Consequent upon the above, notification-wise **Select Lists** as per merit cum preference of the candidates against the available posts is given in Annexure 'B' to this notification.
